DESCRIPTION

<en> Tonneau chair designed by Pierre Guariche in the late 1950s, produced by Steiner.

The molded plywood seat forms a curved shell with a distinctive lumbar opening, a defining feature of the model. It stands on a slender black lacquered tubular metal base. The original seat cushion enhances comfort while preserving the purity of the design.

A key model in Pierre Guariche's 1950s work, it reflects his research into ergonomic seating, combining industrial techniques with soft, organic lines.
