## **DESCRIPTION**

Solid wood chair with an architectural structure composed of interlocking cubic elements forming the seat, backrest and legs. The geometric design, defined by regular recesses and protrusions, gives this piece a sculptural presence and striking visual rhythm.

Made in the 1970s, this chair belongs to the brutalist movement and to the explorations of craftsmen and designers who considered wood as both a constructive and expressive medium. The balance between geometric rigor and

artisanal character places it at the intersection of furniture and sculpture.
