DESCRIPTION

Pair of solid wood chairs, found in an apartment at the La Plagne ski resort, furnished by Pierre Guariche in the 1960s.

Likely custom-made, these chairs stand out for their understated construction: a rectangular seat, simple legs, and a flat screwed-on backrest. The woodwork is raw, showing a beautiful patina from use.

Provenance: La Plagne, a ski resort where Guariche played a major role in interior design.
