DESCRIPTION

Set of chairs in black lacquered wood and leather, Swiss architect work from the 1980s.

These chairs are defined by their rigorous construction, composed of a square-section wooden frame forming a strict structure, within which a stretched leather seat and back are inserted. The absence of ornament and the precision of the lines reflect an architectural approach to furniture, where each element contributes to a balanced composition of volumes. The contrast between black wood and warm leather enhances the graphic presence of the set, in a minimalist and radical spirit typical of confidential, custom-made productions.

Likely commissioned for a private interior or professional space, following a coherent dialogue between architecture and furniture.
