Its backrest and footrest articulate to transform from an upright armchair into a full recliner. The welded steel frame is padded with expanded polyurethane foam and upholstered in removable yellow and black fabric decorated with star motifs.

Designed in 1980 and produced by Cassina, this piece stands as one of the brand's most distinctive armchairs, combining comfort, innovation and versatility.
