DESCRIPTION

Solid pine stool with an inverted U-shaped base, produced for the furnishings of the Les Arcs 1800 ski resort. The design relies on an elementary and sturdy construction, emphasizing stability and structural clarity. The use of solid pine and restrained form relates to furniture conceived for collective use in a mountain environment, within the context of the furnishing programs overseen by Charlotte Perriand.
