DESCRIPTION

The Max bookcase by Ettore Sottsass, created by the famous Italian designer, is an iconic piece that reflects his distinct aesthetic. Designed in the 1980s, this bookcase is characterized by a bold and colorful structure, typical of the Memphis movement, of which Sottsass was one of the founders.

Blending geometric shapes, various colors and materials, the Max bookcase is distinguished by its asymmetrical lines, wooden structure covered with polychrome melamine, and plexiglass.
